Condition	We have seen some 2021 Camaro's with the HFV6 3.6L LGX engine come in with the SES/ CEL/ MIL on and DTC's P0011 and or P0016 set in the ECM. This is happening on brand new vehicles with less than 150 miles.
	At this time we are unsure of the cause for this concern but replacement of the solenoids has shown the solenoid is not internally failed.

Correction:

At this time we would like you to cycle the connector to both intake camshaft actuator solenoids(unplug inspect connector and plug it back in).

Then take the vehicle and drive it to see if the code returns.

If the code(s) return, follow SI diagnostics for repair.

If the code does not return, return the vehicle to the customer.

NOTE: The root cause for this concern is under investigation and this PI will be updated or removed when more information is known.
