Some 2019 model year 4Runner vehicles may exhibit a squeal/squeak noise from the front brakes with light to moderate braking. Follow the Repair Procedure in this bulletin to address this condition.

Confirm the lot number on the pad kit packaging is AFTER 05/26.
 For example: E26 → May 26th (E = May, 26 = 26th day of the month).



Repair Procedure

1. Confirm the condition exists.
 Does the vehicle exhibit a squeal/squeak noise from the front brakes with light to moderate braking?
 - **YES** — Continue to step 2.
 - **NO** — This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.

Repair Procedure (continued)

2. Replace the front brake pads.
 - A. Remove the front brake pads.
