Thor Motor Coach has been informed that Cummins Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2021 Cummins L9 engines manufactured between March 27, 2019 and June 15, 2021. Cummins has initiated recall 21E-063. In addition, Daimler Trucks North America LLC (DTNA) has released a Companion Campaign, FL897. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

***Reason for
this recall***

A fuel leak may occur in the fuel hoses between the fuel pump and remote filter head. A fuel leak in the presence of an ignition source may increase the risk of a fire. Persons operating in or around the vehicle may see smoke before sufficient heat creates a fire. This affects the following Thor Motor Coach products: certain model year 2021-2022 Tuscany and Venetian motorhomes.

***What they
will do***

Cummins has released field Safety Campaign #C2465 to correct this condition by replacing the subject fuel lines with fuel lines of a new design. This campaign is currently available at Cummins Distributors and authorized Warranty Dealers. The repair will be completed free of charge and most applications will require approximately 1.0 hours to complete.

***What we need
you to do***

Contact the nearest Cummins Distributor or authorized Warranty Dealer to arrange to have this campaign performed on your engine. The distributor or dealer will work with you to schedule the best date to complete this repair.

We urge you to have this repair performed as soon as possible. In the meantime, however, Cummins advises you to periodically check the remote fuel filter hoses for signs of leaking and immediately seek repairs if leaks are identified.

If you have questions or concerns about this recall, please contact your local Cummins Distributor or authorized warranty dealer.
