Technical Background

Incorrectly installed roof rack components can cause usage and wind noise concerns.

Service

The carrier bars for the roof rack should have a sticker noting the proper direction of installation.





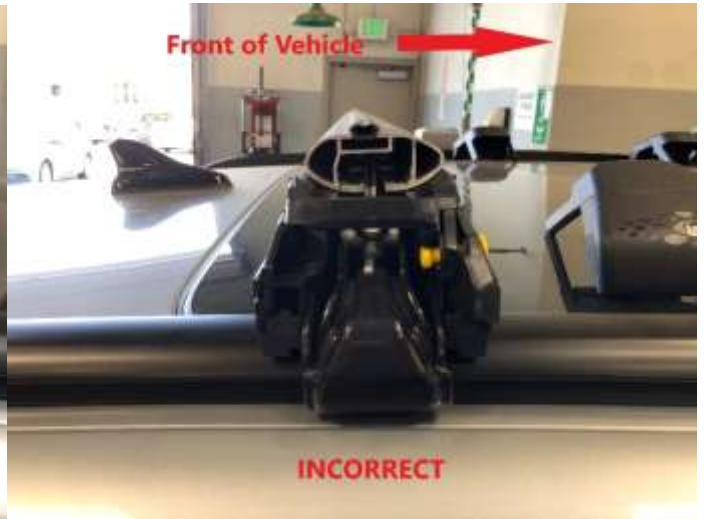
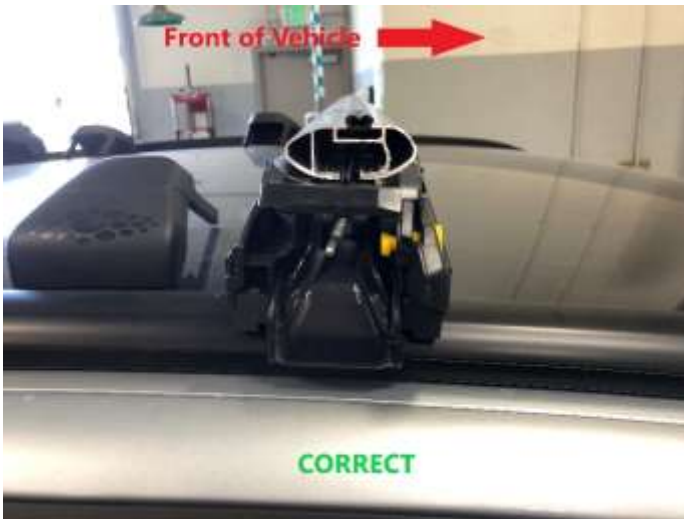

The carrier bars should be installed with the more tapered edge toward the rear, much like an airplane wing. Note the below photos showing correct and incorrect installations of the carrier bars.



Additionally, ensure the rubber strips (called out in the installation instructions as “cover profile”) are installed correctly. Once installed, the cover profile should be almost flush with the top of the carrier bar. It is possible to install the seals upside down. Note the below photos showing correct and incorrect installations of the cover profile.
