PSS 91 "Maneuver assist: fault" message is displayed on the instrument cluster

Condition

Customer states:

- The message "Maneuver assist: fault. Please contact service" is briefly displayed on the instrument cluster after the vehicle is started.
- The message disappears after a few seconds.
- After the message disappears, the maneuver assist system functions normally.

Workshop findings:

- The concern is sporadic.
- No relevant DTCs are stored in the driver assist systems control module, J1121 (address word 00A5).

Technical Background

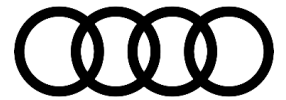
A timing issue in the software causes the message to briefly be displayed.

Production Solution

This bulletin will be updated when more information is available. A solution is currently under development.

Service

1. Explain to the customer that a solution may be forthcoming for the 3rd quarter of 2023 and that no repairs are necessary at this point. Do not replace any components for this condition since this will not resolve the customer's concern.
2. Create a PSS record in the PSS application through the Pending Service Solutions (PSS) link in AccessAudi (under *Related Links* >> *Service*), or through the Technical Assistance page in Elsa.

Workaround

The maneuver assist can be deactivated to prevent the message from popping up on vehicle start.

To do so, either deactivate the maneuver assist via *Car >> Parking aid >> Maneuver assist*.

Or

With the parking aid active, select *>> Maneuver assist*.



Tip: The settings are linked to the myAudi user account. Therefore, this setting has to be changed for every user separately should the customer desire to do so.
