

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Some vehicles equipped with a seat ventilation system may have the passenger seat belt warning light on, even though there is no passenger in the seat. This concern may be caused by an overly sensitive detection of the occupancy sensor. The weight of the seat ventilation unit may be captured by the occupancy sensor, resulting in a false detection.

To eliminate this concern, the construction of the pad (2) has been changed so that the weight of the seat ventilation unit (1) is spread to parts other than the occupancy sensor (3).



Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

- 3. Verify the repair.
