Nissan is conducting a dealer inventory quality action to torque the bolts on the running boards to correct specification on **38** specific MY2022 Nissan Pathfinder vehicles identified in Service Comm and National Service History – Open Campaigns. The subject bolts were not torqued to specification during installation.

Affected vehicles are **not** subject to stop sale and are either currently in dealer inventory or assigned and in transit to the dealer.

PC851 - 2022 PATHFINDER RUNNING BOARD TORQUE

1. Locate the running board mounting bolts. (Figure 1)

Note:

Bolts can be accessed without raising the vehicle on a lift.



- 2. Torque the Running board mounting bolts on both sides of the vehicle.
 - Using a T40 torx head socket, torque the 12 running board to bracket mounting bolts (3 brackets on each side of the vehicle, 2 bolts on each bracket)
 - Torque to 24 N•m (2.4 kg-m, 18 ft-lbs).
