Android Display Audio Screen Goes Blank During LaneWatch™ **Camera Aiming**



2016 Pilot with Android Display Audio

When LaneWatch camera aiming is complete, the Android Display Audio (ADA) screen should switch back to the LaneWatch camera view. However, due to a bug in the audio/audio-navigation unit, the screen may go blank and the unit may lock up instead.

If that happens, here's a work-around so you can check if the camera aiming is complete.

- 1. Turn the ignition to OFF, then back to ON.
- 2. Press the LaneWatch button on the end of the turn signal lever and watch the ADA screen.
 - If you see Aiming Failed, check your aiming target setup and repeat the aiming procedure.
 - If you see the LaneWatch camera view, go to step 3.
- 3. Turn off the LaneWatch camera and enter the Audio Diagnostic Mode. Select **Detail Information and Settings**, Functional Setup, and LaneWatch.
- Check the **Aiming** line on the **LaneWatch** screen.



- If you see **OK**, camera aiming is complete.
- If you see NG, check your aiming target setup and repeat the aiming procedure.
