

Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Check Engine Light Is On. DTC's P0070 And P0073 Are Active For The Ambient Air Temperature Sensor

Discussion: The check engine light may be illuminated. Upon scanning the vehicle you may find multiple DTC's set for the ambient air temperature circuit including P0070 and P0073.

Repair: The Ambient Air Temperature sensor may not have been fully seated. Inspect the D1504A AAT sensor connector behind the left grill. Disconnect and reconnect the connector to confirm it is fully seated.
