This condition will most likely occur on vehicles with under 100 miles and/or vehicle that are still in dealer inventory.
Cause	The K36 Restraints Control Module (SDM) has an Internal Electronic failure.

#### **Correction:**

If you experience this concern and DTC: U3000 SYM 49 is set current, please do not erase the DTC and replace the K36 Restraints Control Module (SDM). Engineering would like to get the part back in its failed state and resetting the code before replacing the module may erase important data.

Note: Do not attempt to clear DTC's. Clearing DTC's will erase the needed information captured in the module.

Note: The failed part must be returned through the special part return process. If the part is not returned within the designated time limit, the claim will be rejected
