PSS 91 Intersection assist arrows flicker after the vehicle is started

Condition

Customer states:

- After the vehicle is started and the back-up/overhead view camera is activated via the button in the
 center console, the intersection assist/rear cross traffic assist arrows flicker in the upper MMI screen
 (Figure 1).
- As soon as the vehicle starts moving, the concern is no longer present.
- If the back-up camera is activated by putting the vehicle into reverse, the concern is not present.

Workshop findings:

The customer concern can be reproduced.

Technical Background

A software issue in the control module for driver assist systems, J1121 (address word 00A5) may cause the customer concern.

Production Solution

This bulletin will be updated when more information is available. A solution is currently under development.

Service

- 1. Explain to the customer that a solution is forthcoming for the 1st quarter of 2023 and that no repairs are necessary at this point. Do not replace any components for this condition since this will not resolve the customer's concern.
- 2. Create a PSS record in the PSS application through the Pending Service Solutions (PSS) link in AccessAudi (under *Related Links >> Service*), or through the Technical Assistance page in Elsa.
