Condition	Some customers may comment on seeing water leaking from the sunroof area. Customers may also comment on hearing water rushing as they drive the vehicle.			
Cause	The cause of the condition may result from sunroof drain hose and drain concerns, or the sunroof frame.			
Correction	<ul> <li>Note: Based on warranty claims, waterleaks may originate from sealing problems within the sunroof housing, or from front and/or rear drain hoses that were not properly connected from the assembly plant. Referencing the latest version of PIC5260 might be helpful in diagnosis of a sunroof waterleak issue.</li> <li>Perform a water test, if the waterleak is duplicated, the technician should use the general</li> </ul>
