- 4. After draining, double bag the filter, preferably a Ziplock bag if possible.
- 5. Tag the bag with the VIN and mileage.
- 6. Wrap the bag with a PIG® mat to contain any possible leaks and insert into a shipping box, along with a copy of the work order.
