PORSCHE Rear Seat Entertainment (YHR/YHU)

Revision: This bulletin replaces bulletin Group 9 11/18, dated October 15, 2018.

- Model Year: As of 2018 up to 2021
- Concern: Retrofitting
- Restriction: ONLY for vehicles with Porsche Rear Seat Entertainment (9WU) preparation up to and including production date 48-2020 (week-year).
- Porsche Rear Seat Entertainment (PRSE) is a high-resolution, anti-glare 10.1-inch touchscreen, including Notes: folding mounting arm. The touchscreen is fitted on the back of the backrest on the driver and/or passenger seat (\Rightarrow *Figure 1*).

The system can even be used outside of the vehicle.

Wireless Porsche Bluetooth® headphones, which are ideal for the Porsche Rear Seat Entertainment system, can also be ordered.

Work Procedure: 1 Installing new screen

1.1 Connect battery charger (\Rightarrow Workshop Manual '2X00IN Battery trickle charging).

NOTICE

Display unit installed/removed/operated incorrectly

- Risk of damage to the surface/leather on front seat or display unit
- Risk of damage to the display unit screen
- \Rightarrow Do not use sharp-edged tools for installing/removing the display unit.
- \Rightarrow During installing/removal: Do not press the display.

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- 1.2 Fold out the mounting arm on the back of the screen (\Rightarrow *Figure 3*).
 - 1 Mounting arm
 - 2 Screen

- 1.3 Align mounting arm with screen attached with the opening (back of front seat backrest) and carefully guide it into the opening (\Rightarrow *Figure 4*).
 - 1 Mounting arm
 - 2 Screen
 - Opening (back of front seat backrest)
- 1.4 Carefully push the screen towards the front seat backrest (⇒ *Figure 4* -arrow-) until the locking mechanism on the mounting arm engages securely.
- 2 Configuring new screen
 - 2.1 Switch on the new screen (\Rightarrow *Figure 5*).
 - 1 On/Off switch
 - 2 Edge of screen (bottom)
 - 2.1.1 Press the On switch at the bottom of the screen for approx. 2 seconds.
 - 2.1.2 The system boots up.

Information

When you switch on the display unit for the first time, the default language is preset to "English".

- 2.2 Set the system language (\Rightarrow Figure 6)
 - 1 "Select language" display
 - **2** Available languages
 - **3** Confirm
 - 2.2.1 Select the desired system language from the list of available languages $(\Rightarrow Figure 6 2 -).$
 - 2.2.2 Confirm the selected language (\Rightarrow *Figure 6*-**3**-).
- 2.3 Configure device (\Rightarrow *Figure 7*)
 - 1 "Configure device" display
 - 2 Configure new device
 - Restore a backup/copy (Google account)

Select whether:

- you want to configure the device as a "New" device (⇒ Figure 7-2-).
- you want to access "existing apps/data", e.g. from an existing Google account (backup or copy of a device ⇒ Figure 7 -3-).

2.3.1 Select the menu item "Configure new device". Access data for the customer's Google account is **NOT** known.

The customer can make a copy of a device or of existing apps/data later.

2.3.2 The display changes automatically to the next menu item.

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- 2.4 Configure WiFi network (\Rightarrow Figure 8 and \Rightarrow Figure 9)
 - 1 Configure WiFi
 - 2 Activate/switch on WiFi
 - 3 Next menu item
 - 2.4.1 Switch on WiFi (\Rightarrow Figure 8-2-).

Additional access data is required!

- 2.4.2 Select available network. Complete further steps to establish a connection according to instructions on the display.
 - 1 WiFi activated
 - 2 A network is available
 - 3 Next menu item
- 2.4.3 If there is no network available: \Rightarrow Select "Next menu item". Continue with Step 2.5.
- 2.5 Select/activate the device protection function $(\Rightarrow Figure \ 10)$

The display unit can be protected against misuse by unauthorized persons.

- 1 Screen unlock display
- 2 No lock
- 3 Swipe
- 4 Pattern
- 5 PIN
- 6 Password
- 2.5.1 If the customer is not present: Select "No lock" (\Rightarrow Figure 10-2-).
- 2.5.2 The display changes automatically to the next menu item.

- 2.6 Set device name (\Rightarrow *Figure 11*)
 - Device name
 - 2 Keyboard display
 - **3** Input field
 - 4 Confirm

Information Special characters CANNOT be entered!

2.6.1 Enter a suitable name for this screen.

For example, enter a name indicating where the screen will be used: left seat = "PRSE left" (\Rightarrow *Figure 11*-inset-)

- 2.6.2 Confirm your entry.
- 2.7 Confirm the "Setup complete" display with "Done" (\Rightarrow *Figure 12*).
 - 1 Setup complete
 - **2** Done





The "Start screen" (\Rightarrow Figure 13) appears.

- 2.8 Switch off the screen (\Rightarrow Figure 5 and \Rightarrow Figure 14)
 - 2.8.1 Briefly press the Off switch (\Rightarrow *Figure 5*-1-) at the bottom of the screen: The device enters Standby mode.

 \Rightarrow When the ignition is switched on, the device is also switched on. After a while, the device switches back to Standby mode automatically.
