SERVICE INFORMATION

<u>Do not</u> swap combination meter modules between **APPLIED VEHICLES** vehicles <u>for any reason</u>.

Due to a new electrical architecture, the vehicle mileage is now stored in multiple control modules.

When a mileage difference is detected between modules, the module with the <u>lower</u> value will be immediately overwritten, replacing it with the higher mileage.

If a new combination meter module is installed, it will automatically be overwritten to the correct vehicle mileage.
