PASSENGER FRONT DOOR GLASS SQUEAKS WHEN GOING UP AND DOWN

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2021 Rogue (T33)

APPLIED VIN AND DATE: VINs starting with 5N1 and built before September 15, 2021

IF YOU CONFIRM

The customer experiences an abnormal noise when operating the passenger (RH) side front door glass,

AND

The noise goes away when the glass is pressed inward from the outside of the vehicle.

ACTION

- 1. Replace the RH side Front Door Outside Molding.
- 2. Clean the RH side front door glass.
- 3. Confirm that the noise is no longer present.

IMPORTANT: The purpose of ACTION (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You MUST closely follow the entire SERVICE PROCEDURE as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing this repair.

- 1. Replace the RH side Front Door Outside Molding.
 - Refer to the ESM: BODY EXTERIOR, DOORS, ROOF & VEHICLE SECURITY >
 EXTERIOR > REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION > DOOR OUTSIDE MOLDING



- 2. Clean the RH side front door glass.
- 3. Confirm that the noise is no longer present.
