Pedestrian Alert System Sound

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin serves as awareness for the normal operation of pedestrian alert system.

MODELS:

2021 (JL) Jeep Wrangler

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: North America, EMEA and APAC.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles equipped with the 2.0L I4 DOHC DI Turbo PHEV Engine (Sales Codes ECX).

DISCUSSION:

When in electric drive mode while vehicle is in drive/reverse you can hear the pedestrian alert sound.

This is standard operation in order to alert pedestrians outside of the vehicle, that the vehicle is preparing to move.

Shifting to park or out of electric mode will turn the pedestrian alert sound off.
