Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Temperature Gauge Running Hot, Engine Cooling Warning Lamp On, Cluster Chime For The Condition, Radiator Cooling Fan Does Not Turn On

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Owner complains temperature gauge runs hot and or cooling lamp is on and the cluster warning chime sounds for a run hot condition. Technician observed the vehicle is running hot and the cooling fan is not turning on.

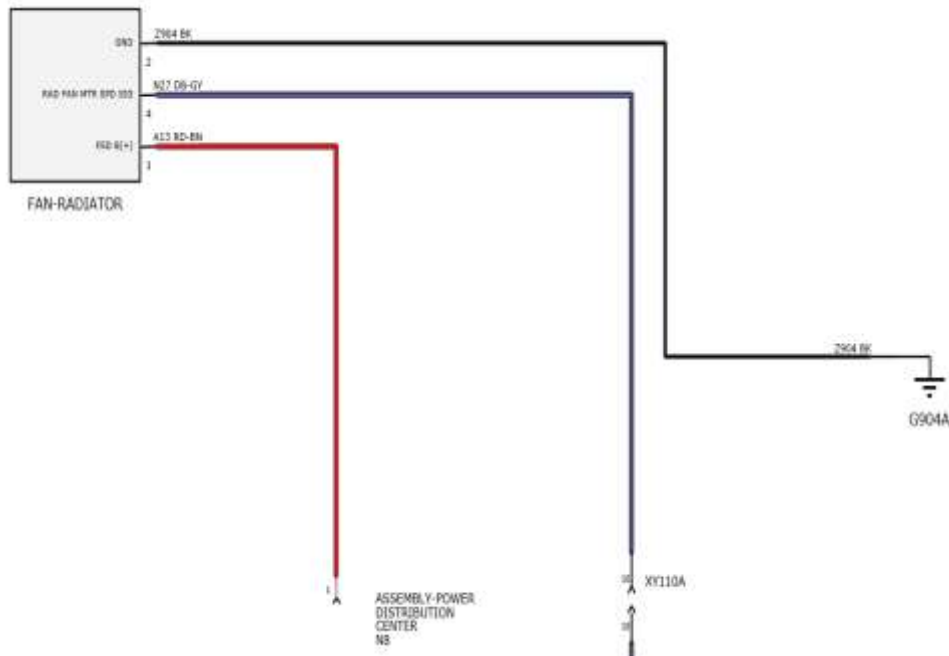
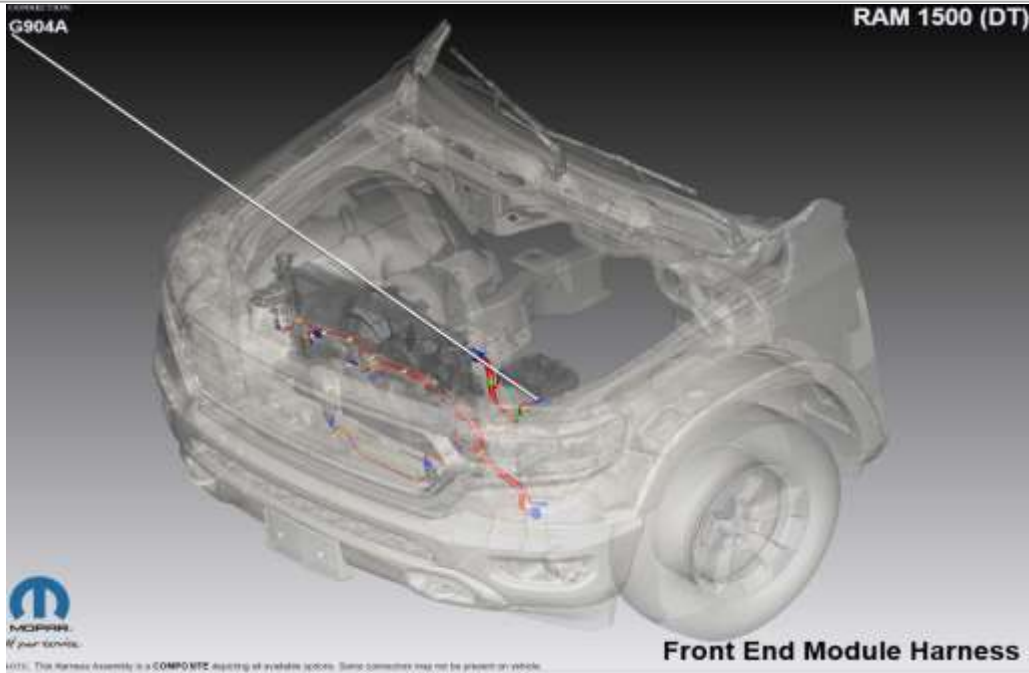


Fig 2, 5.7 example

Repair Procedure: Use the scan tool PCM, Actuators, Radiator Cooling Fan PWM Duty Cycle, select 80% duty cycle to actuate and test the fan, while moving the wires of the involved fan circuits to locate any connection issues. Inspect the G904A ground location, clean and secure the ground location as needed, no parts are required Fig 1, 2 .
