Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Transfer Case Gear Motor/Actuator Installation Guidelines.

NOTE: Do not attempt to rotate the Transfer case gear motor/actuator to align with transfer case shaft prior to installations. This will lead to potential damage of the unit, and or shift errors/DTCs

Discussion: When installing a replacement transfer case gear motor/actuator assembly, it is important to ensure the transfer case shift fork is in the proper position. All transfer case gear motors/actuators are shipped in the AWD/2WD position See (**Figure 1**). Prior to installing the new gear motor/actuator, manually place the transfer case into the AWD/2WD position.


