Safety Recall Communication – Continental Tire the Americas, LLC (“CTA”) Campaign #21T-001

Continental Tire the Americas, LLC (“CTA”) announced a voluntary recall involving 93,959 passenger tires. These tires may have been installed on certain 2019 through 2020 Model Year (KL) Jeep Cherokee and 2019 through 2021 (MP) Jeep Compass vehicles during vehicle assembly.

IMPORTANT: Some of the involved tires may be installed on certain 2019 through 2020 Model Year (KL) Jeep Cherokee and 2019 through 2021 (MP) Jeep Compass vehicles in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these tires before retail delivery of the vehicle. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to approximately \$21,000 per vehicle.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Affected tires may experience a carcass break in the sidewall with sudden air loss or could develop a belt edge separation which could lead to a partial or full tread/belt loss. Tires may experience a sudden air loss without warning while others may exhibit visible localized tread wear which may manifest as excessive vibration and/or bulging in the tread area. These conditions could increase the risk of serious injury or death.

SERVICE ACTION

CTA is conducting a safety recall campaign to replace the affected tires that have been sold, either as original equipment tires, replacement tires, or are in dealer inventories.

The remedy for this condition is currently available via CTA. Dealers can locate the CTA Service Bulletin on the Mopar TireWorks website under Resources/Recall Information.
