Symptom/Vehicle Issue: When The PTO Is Engaged, Engine RPM Will Not Exceed 1100 RPM And The Engine Surges. Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTCs) P061B – Internal Control Module Torque Performance, And/Or P064B – PTO Control Module, Set.

Discussion: A small number of customers may experience issues with PTO operation. These issues include:

- Engine RPM will not exceed 1100 RPM with the PTO engaged
- Engine RPM surging with the PTO engaged
- PTO shuts down with DTC P061B and/or P064B setting.

If you have a vehicle with one of the issues listed above, be sure to perform all published diagnostics for the specific condition. Verify that the PTO system installed is installed properly, and is properly programmed per the customer's preferences. Also verify the PCM is at the latest available calibration.

If no issues are found, the issue may be related to software. Engineering is currently investigating potential software updates, in addition to those already released, to address these conditions.

Rather, it captures all previous cases known that appear to be similar or related to the vehicle symptom / condition.
