Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Head Lamp Smart Lighting Module Left Or Right Locks Up After Flash, Head Lamps Will Not Turn On, Turn Signals Do Not Operate

Technician Observation: Headlamp or turn signal lamps do not operate after a flash update or a service repair. DTC P0602-00 Control Module Programming Error/Not Programmed sets in the SLML or SLMR.


Repair Procedure: Vehicle had recent service module update and the front headlamps and or turn signals no longer operate. SLML (Smart Lighting Module Left) or SLMR (Smart Lighting Module Right) can no longer be accessed and or head lamps or turn signals no longer operate. DTC P0602-00 is setting. This condition can only be corrected by replacing the headlamp assemblies with the listed DTC at this time.

NOTE: The lamp with the DTC P0602-00 should be repaired prior to any other communication faults set against the headlamp assembly that has the active DTC P0602-00.

Example of DTC's setting when a proxy alignment is required after replacing the headlamp or SLM module independently.
