Discussion: The customer may complain that the airbag light is illuminated. Upon scanning the vehicles for DTC's you may find B2765-11 RIGHT C-PILLAR IMPACT ACCELERATION SENSOR-CIRCUIT SHORT TO GROUND.

Diagnosis: The right C-Pillar impact sensor wiring may be pinched and shorted to ground at the lower seat belt mounting bracket. Inspect wiring at location shown below.
