## **Technical Background:**

The technician may find camshaft timing faults after a cylinder head or engine replacement. The cam adjuster spacer tubes may not have been transferred from the original engine or cylinder head.

## Service:

If camshaft timing faults are encountered after engine or cylinder head replacement, check for cam adjuster spacer tubes on the camshafts of the original engine. Usually there are not provided on the replacement engine (Figure 1).
