#### **PURPOSE:**

When replacing an Instrument Cluster/Meter assembly in a 2022 Outlander for any reason, the meter does not need to be sent to the Instrument Cluster Store for odometer calibration. In order to calibrate the instrument cluster there is a procedure in the service manual to write the original mileage back to the Instrument Cluster/Meter assembly. Please follow the steps below:

## Service Manual - Vol 5 - "Meter, Warning Lamp & Indicator"

# After replacement of the Instrument Cluster/Meter assembly:

- Drive the vehicle under the following conditions.
  - Drive the vehicle over 18.6 mph/30 kmh
  - > Drive over a distance of 0.6 miles/1km
- Verify original mileage is displaying on the vehicle.

#### Info

The mileage is stored in other control units such as the ABS C/U and is written to the Instrument Cluster/Meter assembly.



The odometer mileage of the combination meter is also stored and memorized in the ABS actuator and electric unit (control unit). When driving 1 km or more after replacement of the combination meter, the memorized mileage in the ABS actuator and electric unit (control unit) is writed into the new combination meter.
