### Condition

#### **Customer states:**

• Noises from rear of vehicle when suspension compresses.

#### Workshop findings:

• The coil spring on the rear axle makes contact with the spring control arm or the track rod. The spring is not seated centrally in the mounting.

### **Technical Background**

The transition point of the coil spring is outside the tolerance.

### **Production Solution**

Improved process.

### Service

Proceed as described below according to Repair Manual>>Chassis>>Suspension, Wheels, Steering>>42 Rear Suspension>>Suspension Strut, Shock Absorber, Coil Spring.

- 1. Check coil spring, spring control arm, and track rod for abrasion (Figure 1).
- 2. If abrasion is found, replace the components affected and the spring plates (top and bottom).
- 3. Proceed with wheel alignment.
