DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit an excessive body vibration when idling or driving after being left in extremely cold weather (-20°C/-4°F or below) for a long time. This is caused by the No.1, No. 3 and No. 4 rubber hardening due to material characteristics.

NOTE: This concern only happens in extremely cold weather, therefore this TSB is only applicable for extremely cold regions. To eliminate this concern, the cold environment performance of the engine mount rubber has been increased by changing the rubber material.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Verify the customer concern by confirming whether the symptom occurs during an extremely cold day (-20°C/-4°F or below).

Does the symptom occur during an extremely cold day (-20°C/-4°F or below)?

Mazda3

- YES: Replace the No.1, No. 3 and No. 4 engine mount rubber with a modified one according to the instructions on MGSS.
 - No. 1 engine mount rubber for Mazda3 only with the following VINS.
 - NOTE: DO NOT replace the No. 1 engine mount on Mazda3 if already replaced under TSB 01-020/19. 2019 Mazda3 (Japan built) vehicles with VINs lower than JM1BP*****143776 (produced before June 1, 2019)
 - 2019-2020 Mazda3 (Mexico built) vehicles with VINs lower than 3MZBP*****120765 (produced before Aug. 29, 2019)
