This condition may be caused by a coolant leak at the outer head bolt boss (1) on the cylinder head:

⇒ To verify this condition, pressure test the cooling system and inspect for a leak in this area. Streaks may also be noticed running down the side of the boss/head as well. Examples of leak are shown above.

If a leak is found in this area it may be caused by porosity within the right or left cylinder head and may require replacement.
