#### **Customer states:**

• The tire pressure monitoring system (TPMS) warning light is on.

#### **Workshop findings:**

• The customer concern can be reproduced.

#### **And**

 The tire pressure monitoring system control module, J502 (address code 0065) <u>cannot</u> be reached with the diagnostic tester.

The following DTC may be stored in the data bus on board diagnostic interface, J533 (address code 0019) as active/static:

• DTC U012700 (Tire Pressure Monitoring Control Module - no communication) with symptom code 131595.

## **Technical Background**



According to ambient conditions, moisture can enter the control module via the pressure equalization element; this leads to failure of the control module.

### **Production Solution**

This bulletin will be updated when more information is available. A solution is currently under development.

#### **Service**

- 1. Check the wiring and pins in the connector for damage and measure the voltage supply at the tire pressure monitoring system control module, J502 (address code 0065).
- 2. If no irregularities can be detected:
  - Replace the tire pressure monitoring system control module, J502 (address code 0065), and also fit with the new bracket, part number 4E0 810 675 B (Figures 1 - 2).

- 3. Make sure that the wiring is routed correctly at the bracket and connector.
  - **Tip:** It is important for the wiring to be routed straight into the connector housing to ensure the correct sealing of the wiring.
- 4. Test the system to ensure all pressures are being properly read.
