
APPLICABLE MODEL(S)/VINS

For models without i-ACTIVSENSE:

2019-2020 Mazda3 (Japan built) with VINS lower than JM1BP*****150364 (produced before July 31, 2019) 2019-2020 Mazda3 (Mexico built) with VINS lower than 3MZBP*****118754 (produced before July 27, 2019)

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles without i-ACTIVSENSE may exhibit that the i-ACTIVSENSE OFF symbol turns on in the instrument cluster after replacing the speedometer. Since vehicles without i-ACTIVSENSE do not have an i-ACTIVSENSE switch, there is no way to clear the i-ACTIVSENSE OFF symbol.



This is caused by a communication error between the new speedometer and the vehicle control module (VCM) due to a software level difference.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify the concern.
- 2. Reprogram the VCM to the latest calibration with the Mazda Modular Diagnostic System (M-MDS), using Mazda Diagnostic And Repair Software (MDARS).
- 3. Verify the repair.
