SUBJECT:

Optimum Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Control Settings For Comfort

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves discussing optimal HVAC setting to maintain comfort.

MODELS:

2022 (WS) Grand Wagoneer/Wagoneer

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: North America.

DISCUSSION:

Customers may complain of feeling cold drafts coming from behind or around legs/laps/feet/ect. Or cold feet, or no heat on feet in the first row seating. Request the customer to run with both front and rear HVAC on at 22 °C (72 °F) for warm up and to maintain comfort. The HVAC should be run in Floor Mode or Mix Mode (defrost/foot) as this will direct heat to the floor area and is the most optimum setting for warm up in **manual override**. Ask customers to also sync the rear HVAC to the driver as well.
