<p>Cause</p>	<p>The cause of the condition may be that when viewed in full sunlight, the mirror appears to be blurry or wavy. The distortion is actually a reflection of the left side I/P vent onto the driver's side glass, as reflected in the mirror.</p>

<p>Correction</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;">6083508</p> <p>View the mirror in daylight with the window up (1) and then down (2). If the distortion is due to the reflection, then no repair is necessary. Otherwise, verify mirror is fully seated prior to replacement.</p> <p>Please communicate to the customer that the OSRVM system is functioning as designed and this is a normal condition of their vehicle. Please share this information with the customer, including a copy of this bulletin.</p>
