Technical Background

The noises are coming from the brake servo unit rubber boot.



This bulletin does not include PHEV vehicles.

Improved rubber boot was introduced gradually in 1st Quarter 2021.

Service

If noises are identified when pressing the brake pedal, proceed as follows:

- · Record an audio file of the complaint.
- Attach the audio file in the DOC-IT database (Include VIN Number in the file).
- Replace Brake Servo Unit according to:

ELSA>>Repair Manual>>Chassis>>Brake System>>47 Hydraulic Components>>Brake Booster/Brake Master Cylinder>>Brake Booster Removing/Installing.
