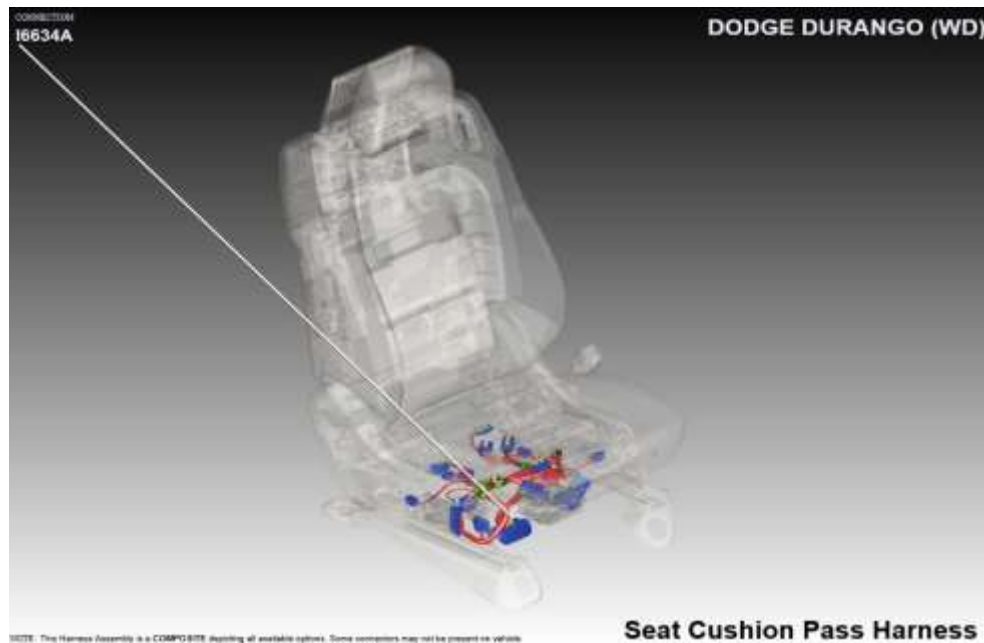

Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Air Bag Lamp On, DTC B00C5-13 Passenger Seat Track Position Restraints Sensor - Circuit Open

Customer Complaint/ Technician Observation: Owner complaint, air bag lamp is on. Technician observed Occupant Restraint Controller (ORC) setting DTC - B00C5-13 Passenger Seat Track Position Restraints Sensor - Circuit Open.

Repair Procedure: Inspect 30-way yellow connector I6634A under the passenger seat. Verify the circuit for seat track position return is secure for the R730 circuit at the B11 connector location (see connector pinouts). Verify the circuit and connector are secure by using the pull-push-pull method Fig 1, 2.

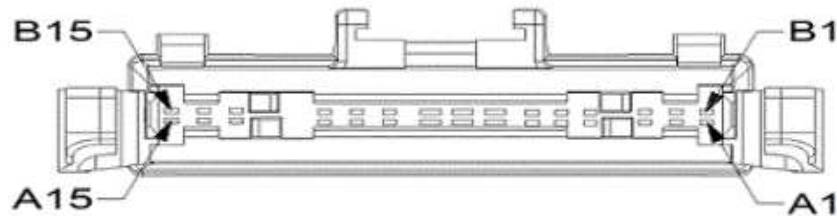

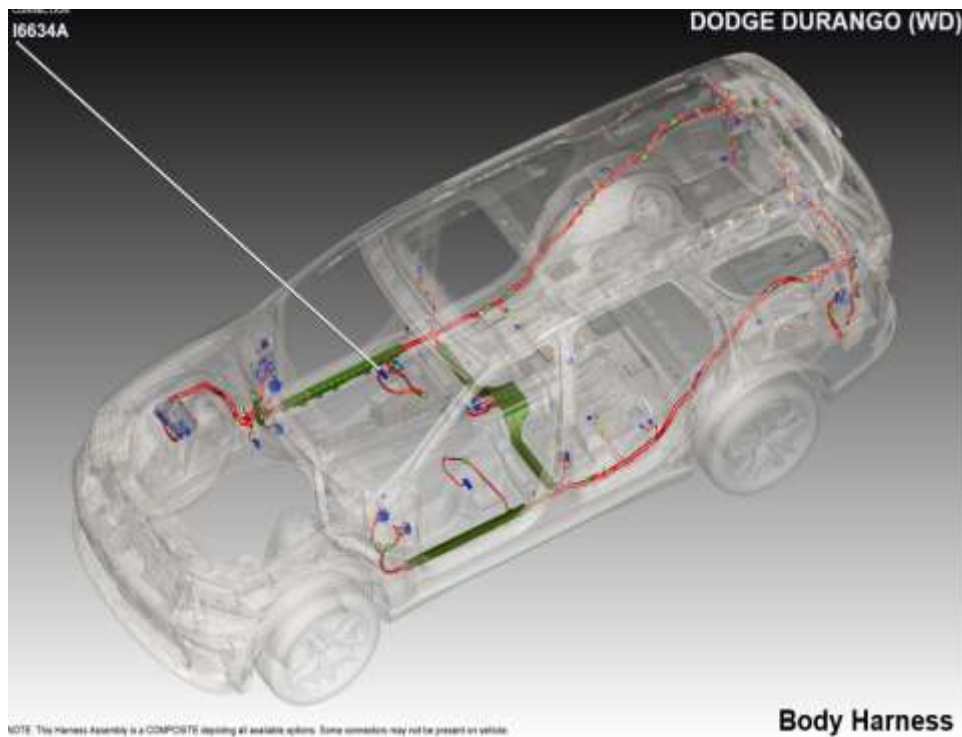
