Condition

Customer states:

- Occasionally, a phone call cannot be ended by using the multi-function steering wheel buttons.
- It is always possible to end the call via the MMI.
- When using Amazon Music, the Amazon Music symbol on the instrument cluster screen is sporadically not completely visible.
- This complaint resolves itself with a bus sleep cycle.

Workshop findings:

- No relevant DTCs are stored.
- Both complaints occur sporadically and may not be reproducible in the workshop.

Technical Background

A software-related issue may cause the complaints listed above.

Production Solution

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Improved instrument cluster software implemented in production.
