DESCRIPTION

Before beginning installation of the accessory illuminated door sill plate, review the information in this Service Alert or the parts may not fit correctly.

NOTE: The scuff plates have a small gap and some movement designed into them so the customer can remove the scuff plates to replace the batteries. DO NOT replace the scuff plates for this normal gap or movement.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

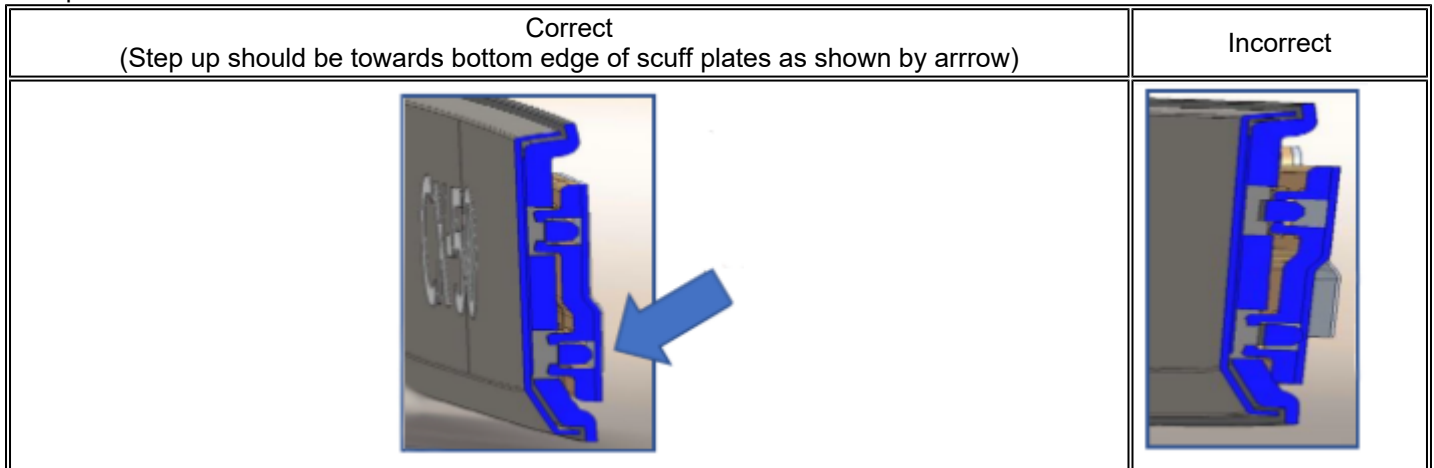
CLIP ORIENTATION

1. Remove both left and right front scuff plates from the foam sleeve.
2. Turn over and observe the orientation of the attachment clips located on the backside of the parts.



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3. Clips should be oriented as shown below.



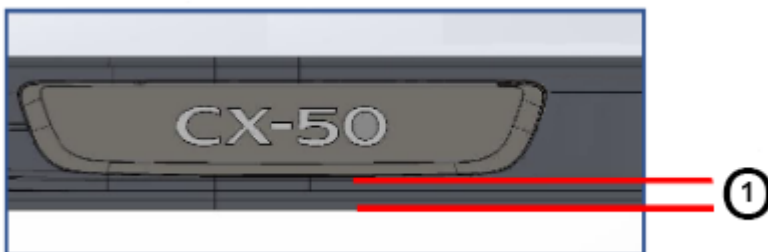
4. If clips are in the wrong orientation, remove them from the scuff plate and reinstall them in the correct orientation.

ADDITIONAL STEPS

Make the following changes to the installation procedure. This is intended to be used in conjunction with the original installation instructions.

NOTE: If you do not have a copy, you can download a copy from the Accessories E-catalog (Installation Instructions). **BE AWARE that the templates must be printed on 11" x 17" paper. If printed on 8½" x 11" or 8½" x 14", the template will *not* be the correct size.**

1. During Step 3 of the installation instructions, in addition to the items already mentioned, also remove the original side plastic trim.
2. Check that the scuff plate is parallel with the frame edge (1).



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
