

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove the tire.
- 2. Remove ALL fasteners from the fender liner.



- 3. Shift the liner upward and outward.
- 4. Hook the section of the liner that was hanging down into the space between the fender and fender garnish.



5. Reinstall and tighten all the fasteners while holding the fender liner in place.

Is the fender liner staying up?

YES: Continue to STEP 7. **NO:** Go back to STEP 2.

- 6. Reinstall the tire.
- 7. Take the vehicle on a short test drive to confirm the liner stays in place.
