Graunch Type Noise From Front Brakes	21MY - Onwards E-PACE, RR Evoque, Discovery Sport
<p><u>Customer Voice:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A customer may report a graunch type noise from the front brakes when coming to a complete stop. <p><u>Technical Description:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A graunch type noise may be heard from the front brakes when bringing the vehicle to a complete stop (within the last 10 feet of a complete stop). <p><u>Status:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Engineering has developed a revised brake pad to address this specific concern.- SSM 75713 (Land Rover) and 75714 (Jaguar) have been published to support diagnosis of this concern and provide the part number of the revised brake pad.- There is a video of the brake noise that this revised pad has been design to resolve.- Please refer to these SSMs should a customer express a concern but, only replace the brake pads with the revised parts if the customer's concern matches the graunch noise in the video attached to the SSM. These brake pads should not be used to address any other brake noise concern.
