Inspect the left rear wheelhouse liner for a rub through condition due to incorrect tire size.

### Service Procedure

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, inspect the left rear wheelhouse liner for a rub through condition.

 If the concern is caused by a rub through condition and the vehicle is <u>not</u> equipped with original equipment (OE) tires, then advise the customer of the importance to use the same tire size and manufacturer as the vehicle was originally equipped with. The repair is not covered as a warranty claim.

**Important:** The same tire size, but a different manufacturer, could result in up to 10 mm difference in actual tire size.

 If the concern is caused by a rub through condition and the vehicle is equipped with the OE tires, please submit a field product report and include pictures and tire information.
