Condition	Some customers may comment on an AEB forward collision icon lamp illuminated in the cluster. No DTCs are present as well as both lane keep assist and cruise are functional.			
Cause	The cause of this condition may be due to the customers vehicle collision settings. The Pedestrian Detection or Forward Collision settings may be set to anything other than 'Alert and Brake.'			
Correction	To correct this condition, set the Pedestrian Detection and Forward Collision settings to 'Alert and Brake.' If the customer does not want automatic braking enabled, then it is normal for this icon to be illuminated to inform the driver of reduced features.  Go to the vehicle settings => collision detection systems => front pedestrian detection. Verify the setting is set to "alert and brake."  Important: If the setting is alert and brake and the AEB light is still on, restore the radio to factory settings.
