# DESCRIPTION

Some customers may report poor A/C performance and/or i-Stop operation concerns due to a leaking A/C condensor.

## **REPAIR PROCEDURE**

- 1. Is the vehicle production before 05/04/2022?
  - YES Go to the next step.

NO - Diagnose the vehicle using MGSS.

- 2. Check the condenser carefully for a leak using the instructions on MGSS (CONDENSER INSPECTION [SKYACTIV-G]).
- 3. Is the condenser leaking?

YES - Replace the condenser using the instructions on MGSS (CONDENSER REMOVAL/INSTALLATION [SKYACTIV-G]).

NO - Diagnose the vehicle using MGSS.
