- 2. Replace all four front hub/wheel bearing bolts, (4x bolts per hub/wheel bearing)
- 3. The bolts can be replaced without removing any suspension components
- 4. Replace\* each bolt one at a time following the sequence illustrated and tightening procedure in the installation section of 204-01 FRONT SUSPENSION > FRONT WHEEL BEARING
