Update 2/25/22

Please note that with the release of PIWIS Tester version 40.800.020 the software for WNA5 has been integrated into the repair for **AMB5 Recall campaign - Reprogramming power electronics**. If a vehicle displays both campaigns, AMB5 should be carried out as normal and WNA5 should be billed for OTU.
