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Customer states:

- When opening and closing the trunk lid, noises from the trunk lid struts can be heard.

Workshop findings:

- Hydraulic flow and/or chafing sounds are emitted from the trunk lid struts during operation.

Technical Background

While operating the trunk lid struts, hydraulic flow and functional noises are audible.

These noises, when extending and retracting the struts, are a typical strut characteristic and design related. They may vary due to component tolerances. The sound frequency and intensity can change depending on strut temperature, the speed, and frequency with which the struts are operated.
