# LOW SPEED TRANSMISSION UPSHIFT IMPROVEMENT

APPLIED VEHICLES:	2022 Pathfinder (R53)

## **IF YOU CONFIRM**

AT22-004

The customer notices a 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> gear upshift while driving at slow speeds and when the transmission's fluid temperature is warming up,

## AND

There are no TCM related DTCs present.

# ACTION

Perform the steps in the **SERVICE PROCEDURE** to:

- 1. Confirm the current TCM part number.
- 2. Reprogram the TCM, if applicable.

**IMPORTANT:** The purpose of **ACTION** (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You MUST closely follow the entire **SERVICE PROCEDURE** as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing this repair.

Bulletins are intended for use by qualified technicians, not 'do-it-yourselfers'. Qualified technicians are properly trained individuals who have the equipment, tools, safety instruction, and know-how to do a job properly and safely. **NOTE:** If you believe that a described condition may apply to a particular vehicle, DO NOT assume that it does. See your Nissan dealer to determine if this applies to your vehicle.

#### SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Using CONSULT-III, confirm the current TCM part number and write it on the repair order.
  - If it matches one of the part numbers in **Table 1**, continue to step 2 below.
  - If it does not match one of the part numbers in **Table 1**, this bulletin does not apply. Go back to ASIST for further diagnostic and repair information.

# NOTICE

Perform the following before starting the reprogramming procedure to prevent damage to the control unit.

- Connect the AC Adapter to the CONSULT PC.
- Connect the CONSULT PC to the Internet via Wi-Fi or a network cable.
- Ensure ASIST on the CONSULT PC has been synchronized (updated) to the current date and all CONSULT software updates (if any) have been installed.
- Turn OFF all external Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> devices (e.g., cell phones, printers, etc.) within
  range of the CONSULT PC and the VI. If Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> signal waves are within range
  of the CONSULT PC or VI during reprogramming, the reprogramming may be
  interrupted.
- Turn OFF all vehicle electrical loads.
- Connect a battery maintainer or smart charger, set to reflash mode or a similar setting, to ensure the battery voltage stays between 12.0 V and 15.5 V.
- 2. Reprogram the TCM.

3. After completing **Erase All DTCs**, print a copy of the CONSULT screen showing the before and after part numbers of the control unit and attach it to the repair order.

(1) Reference the electronic parts catalog and use the Transmission Control Unit (310F6-\*\*\*\*\*) as the Primary Failed Part (**PFP**).

(2) Reference the current Nissan Warranty Flat Rate Manual and use the indicated Flat Rate Time (**FRT**).
