AV CONTROL UNIT SCREEN DELAMINATION

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2020-2021 Titan/Titan XD (A61)
APPLIED DATES: Built from December 2019 to July 2020

IF YOU CONFIRM

The AV Control Unit screen has signs of delamination.

ACTION

Replace the AV Control Unit.

IMPORTANT: The purpose of **ACTION** (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You **MUST** closely follow the entire **SERVICE PROCEDURE** as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing this repair.

Bulletins are intended for use by qualified technicians, not 'do-it-yourselfers'. Qualified technicians are properly trained individuals who have the equipment, tools, safety instruction, and know-how to do a job properly and safely. **NOTE:** If you believe that a described condition may apply to a particular vehicle, **DO NOT** assume that it does. See your Nissan dealer to determine if this applies to your vehicle.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

1. Inspect the AV Control Unit screen for signs of screen delamination (Figure 1).
 - If signs of screen delamination are present, proceed to step 2 to replace the AV Control Unit.
 - If signs of screen delamination are not present, this bulletin does not apply.

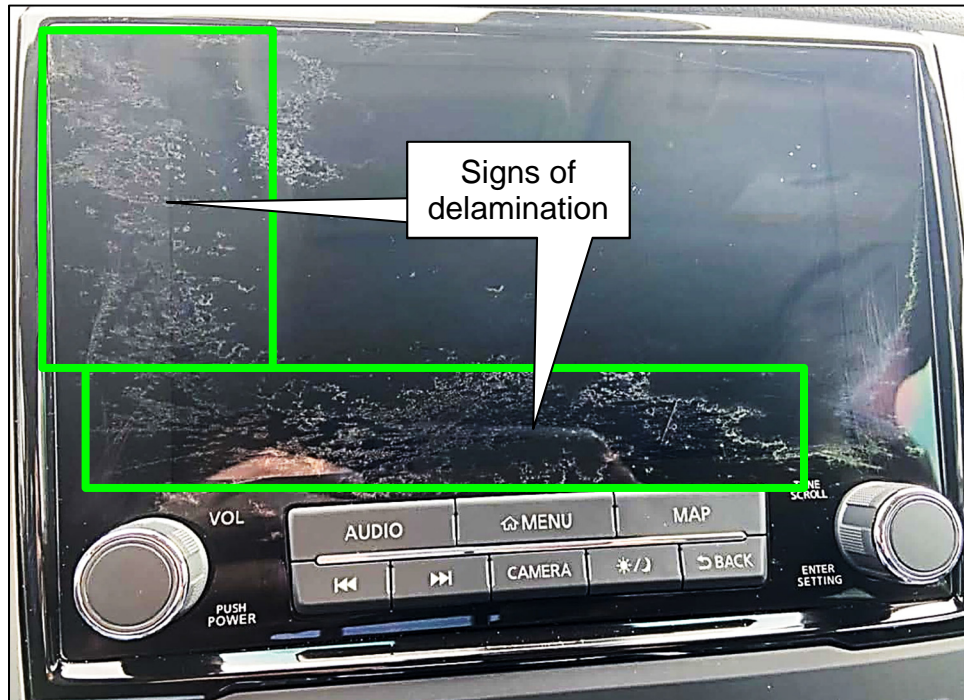

2. Replace the AV Control Unit.
 - Refer to the ESM: **DRIVER INFORMATION & MULTIMEDIA > AUDIO, VISUAL & NAVIGATION SYSTEM > NAVIGATION WITH AMPLIFIER > REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION > AV CONTROL UNIT**
