# MISFIRE DTCS STORED IN THE ECM DURING COLD START

**APPLIED VEHICLES:** 2022 Pathfinder (R53)

# IF YOU CONFIRM

EC22-004

Any single or combination of the following DTCs are present in the ECM during a cold start warm-up cycle on an **APPLIED VEHICLE**:

- P0300 (MULTI CYL MISFIRE)
- P0301 (CYL 1 MISFIRE)
- P0302 (CYL 2 MISFIRE)
- P0303 (CYL 3 MISFIRE)
- P0304 (CYL 4 MISFIRE)
- P0305 (CYL 5 MISFIRE)
- P0306 (CYL 6 MISFIRE)

#### AND

There is no drivability concern present.

# ACTION

Follow the **SERVICE PROCEDURE** in this bulletin to reprogram the ECM, if applicable.

**IMPORTANT:** The purpose of **ACTION** (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You MUST closely follow the entire **SERVICE PROCEDURE** as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing this repair.

Bulletins are intended for use by qualified technicians, not 'do-it-yourselfers'. Qualified technicians are properly trained individuals who have the equipment, tools, safety instruction, and know-how to do a job properly and safely. **NOTE:** If you believe that a described condition may apply to a particular vehicle, DO NOT assume that it does. See your Nissan dealer to determine if this applies to your vehicle.

#### SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Using CONSULT-III, confirm the current ECM part number and write it on the repair order.
  - If it matches one of the part numbers in **Table 1**, continue to step 2 below.
  - If it does not match one of the part numbers in **Table 1**, this bulletin does not apply. Go back to ASIST for further diagnostic and repair information.

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# NOTICE

Perform the following before starting the reprogramming procedure to prevent damage to the control unit.

- Connect the AC Adapter to the CONSULT PC.
- Connect the CONSULT PC to the Internet via Wi-Fi or a network cable.
- Ensure ASIST on the CONSULT PC has been synchronized (updated) to the current date and all CONSULT software updates (if any) have been installed.
- Turn OFF all external Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> devices (e.g., cell phones, printers, etc.) within
  range of the CONSULT PC and the VI. If Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> signal waves are within range
  of the CONSULT PC or VI during reprogramming, the reprogramming may be
  interrupted.
- Turn OFF all vehicle electrical loads.
- Connect a battery maintainer or smart charger, set to reflash mode or a similar setting, to ensure the battery voltage stays between 12.0 V and 15.5 V.

# HINT:

- Take the vehicle for a 10 minute drive in order to meet the following Idle Air Volume Learning conditions:
  - Engine coolant temperature: 70 100°C (**158 212°F**)
  - Battery voltage: More than 12.9 V (At idle)
  - o Transmission: Warmed up
- When reprogramming is complete, you will be required to perform **Throttle Valve Closed Position**, **Idle Air Volume Learning**, **Accelerator Closed Position**, and **DTC Erase**.
- 2. Reprogram the ECM.

**HINT:** If you are not familiar with the reprogramming procedure, click here. This will link you to the "**CONSULT REPROGRAMMING FOR ENGINE OR TRANSMISSION CONTROL MODULE (ECM OR TCM)**" general procedure.

3. After completing **Erase All DTCs**, print a copy of the CONSULT screen showing the before and after part numbers of the control unit and attach it to the repair order.

# **CLAIMS INFORMATION**

#### Submit a Primary Part (PP) type line claim using the following claims coding:

Reprogram Engine Control Module (ECM)	(1)	DE97AA	ZE	32	(2)

(1) Reference the electronic parts catalog and use the ECM Blank (23703-\*\*\*\*) as the Primary Failed Part (**PFP**).

(2) Reference the current Nissan Warranty Flat Rate Manual and use the indicated Flat Rate Time (**FRT**).

**NOTE:** FRT allows adequate time to access DTC codes and reprogram the ECM. No other diagnostic procedures subsequently required. Do NOT clam any Diagnostic Op Codes with this claim.
