# WLD1 - Supplying Wheel Spacer (Workshop Campaign)

Vehicle Type: 911 GT2 RS (991)/911 GT3 RS (991)

Model Year: As of 2016 up to 2019

Equipment: Spare wheel (I-no. 447)

Subject: Spacer

Information: In the event of a flat tire, the spare wheel supplied with the vehicle must only be installed on the front axle.

If tire damage occurs to a wheel on the rear axle, the relevant front wheel must first be installed on the

rear axle and then the spare wheel on the front axle.

A wheel spacer is required in order to install the front wheel on the rear axle. This wheel spacer

was not assigned to the affected vehicles due to an incorrect parts list.

Remedial Action:

Place the wheel spacer in the vehicle to ensure that the front wheel can be installed on the rear axle in the

event of a flat tire.

### **Unsecured load**


- An unsecured, incorrectly secured or incorrectly positioned spare-wheel bag can slip out of place and endanger occupants when braking, changing direction or in the event of an accident.
- ⇒ Never transport the spare wheel bag in the passenger compartment unsecured.
- ⇒ Always stow the wheel spacer in the spare wheel bag secured on the passenger seat.

Work Procedure: 1 Remove the spare wheel together with the holder from the passenger seat and open the spare

wheel bag.

- 2 Stow the wheel spacer ⇒ Placing the wheel spacer in the vehicle -1- in the bag ⇒ Placing the wheel spacer in the vehicle -2- as shown in the illustration behind the tool bag on the inside of the rim of the spare wheel ⇒ Placing the wheel spacer in the vehicle -3-.
- 3 After placing the wheel spacer in the vehicle, close the spare wheel bag and strap the spare wheel with the holder to the passenger seat.
- 4 Enter the campaign in the Warranty and Maintenance booklet.
