Condition

The customer complains of a lack of cool air coming from the A/C vents, or intermittent A/C fan function. The workshop finds the following fault present:

- => Control unit: Air conditioning (BKE)
- => Fault code: 008300 Heater/fresh-air blower motor front electrical fault

Technical Background

The air conditioning control unit (BKE) contains a current-limiting function to prevent damage to the blower motor upon cold starting the vehicle. Therefore, if the fan settings on the A/C control panel in the center console are set to a high fan speed at cold start, the blower regulator may not be able to regulate the desired voltage. The BKE then misdiagnoses the lack of voltage regulation as an electrical fault with the blower motor.

Service Information

Porsche are actively investigating this topic. The solution to this topic will be software-related.

Please perform a VAL to document the occurrence of any fault codes stored in the BKE. As this topic is softwarerelated, **replacing parts (e.g., blower motor, A/C control unit) is not guaranteed to correct the customer's concern. Except in critical cases, please refrain from replacing parts at this time.**

Until a permanent software solution is available, the misdiagnosis of the blower motor may be remedied by starting the vehicle with a low A/C fan speed. The desired fan speed may be set approximately 30 seconds after vehicle start.
