Audio Sound Stops and "No Audio Connection" Message Appears

AFFECTED VEHICLES

SYMPTOM

Audio sound stops and No Audio Connection message appears in the audio display.

NOTE: This is not related to MOST ring break conditions.

POSSIBLE CAUSE

Audio amplifier software error.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Replace the audio amplifier.





REPAIR PROCEDURE


1. Remove the cargo floor board.




2. Open the retaining tabs, remove the screws, and then remove the tie-down hooks.




3. Remove the left and right cargo strips.




4. Remove the clips and retaining tabs shown below. Then, remove the cargo bin.



5. Remove the clips, and then remove the trim panel.



- 6. Unfasten the associated connectors going into the stereo amplifier.
- 7. Remove the bolts tightened at **9.4 N·m (6.9 lb-ft)**, and then remove the stereo amplifier as shown.



- 8. Replace the stereo amplifier.
- 9. Install the parts in the reverse order of removal.
